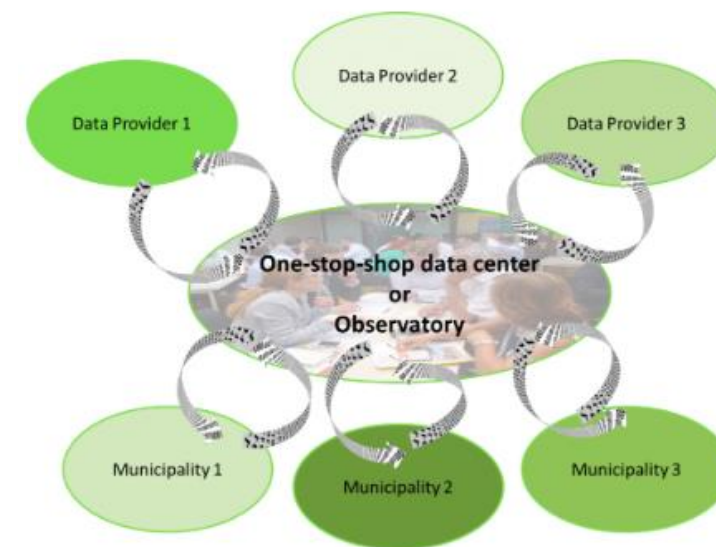


Regional energy 30 GHG & energy data observatories in Europe :

- **Transparency**

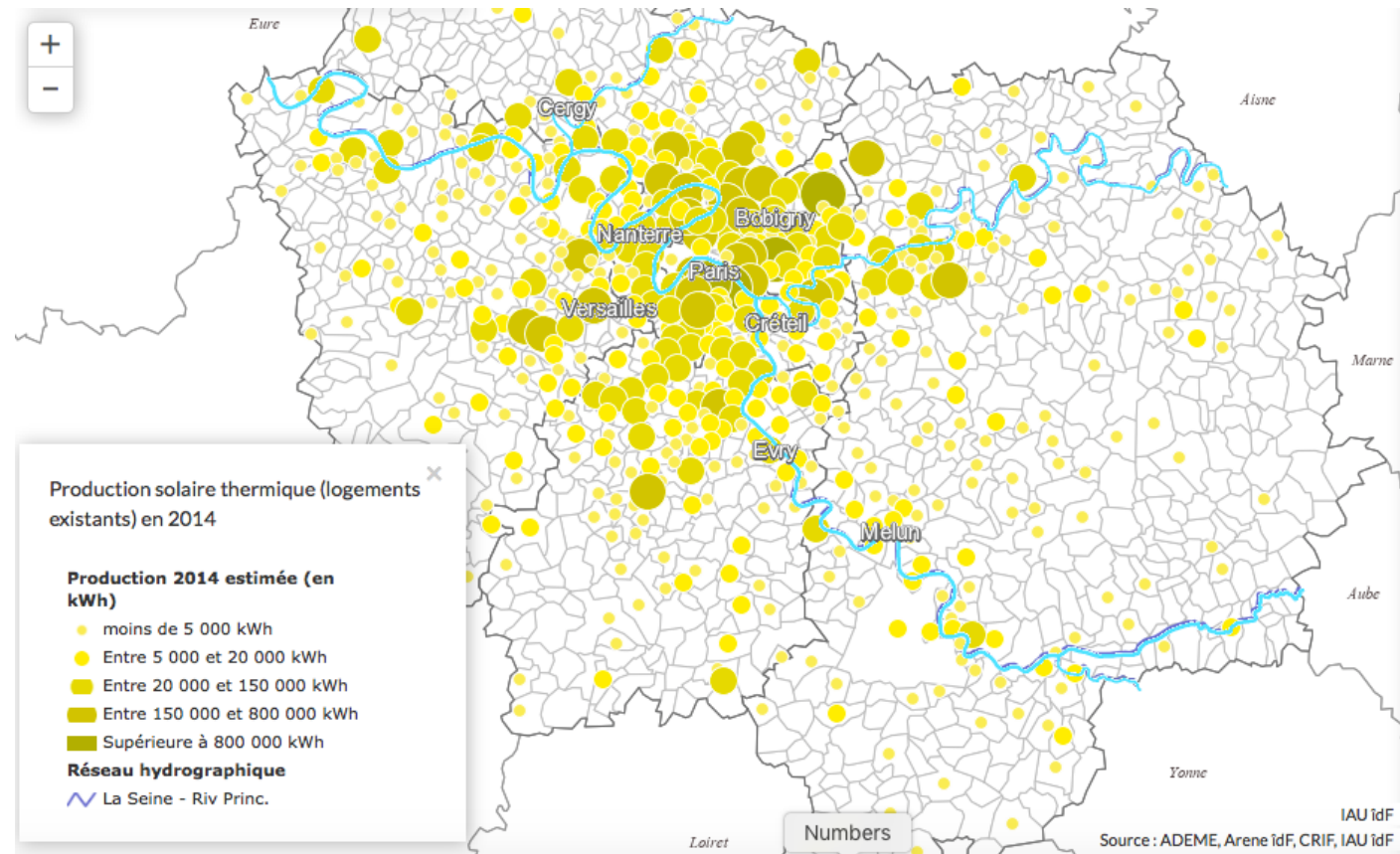
